Shift+Cntrl+D	Reselect

Shift	Add to Selection

Alt+Cntrl+R	Refine Edge
Cntrl+X	Cut Selection

Cntrl+Delete	Fill selection with background colour
Alt+Delete	Fill selection with foreground colour
Alt+click	sample colour/area
Number keys	Change paint opacity
Shift+number keys	Change paint flow
[or]	Increase or Decrease Brush Size
Alt+Cntrl+I	Image size
Alt+Cntrl+C	Canvas Size

Cntrl+Z	Undo (prior to 20.0 this was toggle one step back)
Opt+Cntrl+Z	Toggle one step back (CC 20.0)
Shift+Cntrl+Z	Step Forward
Shift+Cntrl+I	Invert Selection
Shift	Add to Selection
Alt	Subtract from Selection

Cntrl+0	Fit To Screen

Layers

Shift + Cntrl + N	Create New Layer
Cntrl + J	Copy to new layer
Cntrl + G	Group Layers
Alt+Cntrl+G	Create clipping layer (adjustment layer to only affect layer below)
Cntrl+E	Merge Layers
Shift+Cntrl+E	Merge Visible
Shift+Cntrl+Alt+E	Merge Visible to new layer (aka 'The Claw')
Cntrl+Alt+A	Select all layers (except background)
